Luzones There have proposals to rename Luzones (Portuguese: Luções, pronounced [lu'sõj]; also Luzones in Spanish) was a demonym used by Portuguese sailors

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during the early 1500s, referring to the Kapampangan and Tagalog people who lived in Manila Bay, Philippines which was then called Lusong (Kapampangan: Lusung, Portuguese: Luçon). The term was also used for Tagalog settlers in Southern Tagalog region, where they created intensive contact with the Kapampangans. they encountered on their journeys. This included a "young prince" named Ache who would later become known as Rajah Matanda

Two types of cholinesterase have been characterized: acetylcholinesterase (also called choline esterase I or erythrocyte cholinesterase), found mainly in chemical synapses and red blood cell...

These reactions are necessary to allow a cholinergic neuron to return to its resting state after activation. For example, in muscle contraction, acetylcholine at a neuromuscular junction triggers a contraction; but for the muscle to relax afterward, rather than remaining locked in a tense state, the acetylcholine must be broken down by a choline esterase.

Each of these populations was an endogamous dialectal group, consisting of multiple residential bands, with no peaceful interaction between the groups.
