G factor (psychometrics) However, the g factor itself is a mathematical construct indicating The g factor is a construct developed in psychometric investigations of cognitive abilities and human intelligence. often used interchangeably to refer to this common core shared by cognitive tests. It is a variable that summarizes positive correlations among different cognitive tasks, reflecting the assertion that an individual's performance on one type of cognitive task tends to be comparable to that person's performance on other kinds of cognitive tasks. The g factor typically accounts for 40 to 50 percent of the between-individual performance differences on a given cognitive test, and composite scores ("IQ scores") based on many tests are frequently regarded as estimates of individuals' standing on the g factor. The terms IQ, general intelligence, general cognitive ability, general mental ability, and simply intelligence are often used interchangeably to refer to this

Least common multiple However, some authors define $\text{lcm}(a, 0)$ as 0 for all a , since 0 is the only common multiple of a and 0. Factor H surprising, therefore, that rare mutations or common single nucleotide polymorphisms (SNPs) in the complement factor H gene (CFH) often result in pathologies Factor H (FH) is a soluble glycoprotein and a member of the regulators of complement activation (RCA) family. Factor H is a large molecule with a molecular weight of approximately 155 kilodaltons and circulates in human blood plasma at concentrations typically ranging from 200-300 micrograms per milliliter. It functions as a complement control protein and plays a critical role in regulating the complement system, particularly the alternative pathway 8e42c40aad

Pioneer factors can exhibit their greatest range of effects on transcription through the modulation of epigenetic factors by recruiting activating or repressing transcription factors that can directly bind condensed chromatin. This property is observed in histone fold-domain containing transcription factors (fork head box (FOX) and NF-Y) and other transcription factors that use zinc finger(s) for DNA binding (Groucho TLE, Gal4, and GATA). They were first discovered in 2002 as factors capable of binding to target sites on nucleosomal DNA in compacted chromatin and endowing competency for gene activity during hepatogenesis. Pioneer factors are involved in initiating cell differentiation and activation of cell-specific genes. They can have positive and negative effects on transcription and are important in recruiting other transcription factors and histone modification enzymes as well as controlling DNA methylation.
