He includes size-variation forms to aid with the reading of hieroglyphs in running blocks of text. In contrast, for example, the Budge Reference has about 1,000 hieroglyphs listed in 50 pages, but with no size variations. 6967e9525b The brazier hieroglyph is used in Egyptian hieroglyphs as a determinative for the 'brazier', or 'flame',

or words related to 'cooking with a brazier', or a substitute. In the language it is used for pehti-(pḥty). 6967e9525b Gardiner does not cross-index signs; once a sign is put on one of his lists, other significant uses may be overlooked. One example of this is □ G16, nbṯ, the ideogram for the Two Ladies, goddesses Wadjet as the cobra and Nekhbet as the white vulture. These are the protective and patron goddesses of the separate Egyptian kingdoms that joined into ancient Egypt, who were both then displayed on the uraeus of Wadjet when the unification occurred and afterward considered jointly to be the protectors of Egypt and the pharaohs.
