The Communist Manifesto Published amid the Revolutions of 1848 in Europe, the manifesto remains one of the world's most influential political documents. Over the next two centuries, physicists investigated this puzzle of lost energy; the result was the concept of entropy. Early heat-powered engines such as Thomas Savery's (1698), the Newcomen

engine (1712) and Nicolas-Joseph Cugnot's steam tricycle (1769) were inefficient, converting about 0.5% of the input energy into useful work output. a work entitled *Fundamental Principles of Equilibrium and Movement* e97980c5b2

Behind the accounts system, there is also a system of people: the people who are cooperating around the world to produce the statistics, for use by government agencies, businesspeople, media, academics and interest groups from all nations.
