The Gaia hypothesis was formulated by the chemist James Lovelock and co-developed by the microbiologist Lynn Margulis in the 1970s. Following the suggestion by his neighbour, novelist William Golding, Lovelock named the hypothesis after Gaia, the primordial deity who was sometimes personified as the Earth in Greek mythology. In 2006,

the Geological Society of London awarded Lovelock the Wollaston Medal in part for his work on the Gaia hypothesis. 92d1a64869

In the 20th century, young Earth creationists revived flood geology as an overarching concept in their opposition to evolution, assuming a recent six-day creation and cataclysmic geological changes during the biblical flood, and incorporating creationist explanations of the sequences of rock strata 92d1a64869

Sidoti is the precursor in his country of academic courses on criminal investigation – searching, interviews, interrogations, evidence collection and preservation, etc. – as applied science to the study of facts that inform court cases.
