Dumbing down Originating in 1933, the term "dumbing down" was movie-business slang, used by screenplay writers, meaning: "[to] revise so as to appeal to those of little education or intelligence". Dumbing-down varies according to subject matter, and usually involves the diminishment of critical thought by undermining standard language and learning standards, thus trivializing academic standards, culture, and meaningful information, as in the case of popular culture. Data cooperative As an entity, a data cooperative is a type of data infrastructure, formed through the voluntary and collaborative pooling efforts of individuals. infrastructure functionalities. As a data infrastructure, data cooperatives are created, owned and operated by community members. The income is not a subsidy, but rather the result of individual economic activity channeled through exchanges that aggregate the data of producers and workers, thereby turning individuals into data

entrepreneurs. Examples include cooperatives of music artists, video producers, and gig workers. Data cooperatives allow individuals to get paid for the data they create and to exercise more pricing power than they would have on their own or in another type of data exchange.
