Educational assessment Assessment data can be obtained by examining student work directly to assess the achievement of learning outcomes or it is based on data from which one can make inferences about learning. Assessment is often used interchangeably with test but is not limited to tests. Assessment can focus on the individual learner, the learning community (class, workshop, or other organized group of learners), a course, an academic program, the institution, or the educational system as a whole (also known as granularity). conditions and effects of various forms of social action and research leading to social action" that uses "a spiral of steps, each of which is composed of a circle of planning, action and fact-finding about the result of the action". It seeks transformative change through the simultaneous process of taking action and doing research, which are linked together by critical reflection. This tension exists between: those Action research is a philosophy and methodology of research generally applied in the social sciences. Kurt Lewin, then a professor at MIT, first coined the term "action research" in 1944 72f88826a9

Qualitative research This type of research typically involves in-depth interviews, focus groups, or field observations in order to collect data that is rich in detail and context. It is particularly useful when researchers want to understand the meaning that people attach to their experiences or when they want to uncover the underlying reasons for people's behavior.
