Benedetta Carlini was born on 20 January 1590, in Vellano, located in the Apennine Mountains, 45 miles (72 km) northwest of Florence. She was born as an only child to Giuliano Carlini, a landlord who owned various properties in Vellano, and Midea Carlini (née d'Antonio Pieri), a sister of the village's parish priest. Giuliano selected the name Benedetta, meaning “blessed,” and designated her for a religious vocation from birth. In 1977, Newman spent some time living on Kibbutz Ga'aton in Israel. She attended ulpan, worked on a farm, and volunteered at the children's house. Women's liberation movement in North America They were not interested in reforming existing social structures, but instead were focused on changing the perceptions of women's place in society and the family and women's autonomy. Rejecting hierarchical structure, most groups which formed operated as collectives where all women could participate equally. Early stories focused on behavior, rather than motivations, but NBC broke with the tradition when it aired a story on The women's liberation movement in North America was part of the feminist movement in the late 1960s and through the 1980s. To members of the WLM rejecting sexism was the most important objective in eliminating women's status as second-class citizens. Typically, groups associated with the Women's Liberation Movement held consciousness-raising meetings where women could voice their concerns and experiences, learning to politicize their issues. Newman was born as Leslie Newman to Jewish parents in New York City in 1955. She developed her pen name by combining her birth name, Leslie, with her Hebrew name, Leah. She started writing poems when she was 8 to cope with her sadness over her family moving from Brooklyn to Long Island. Newman began writing more seriously as a teenager by participating in poetry contests sponsored by Seventeen magazine. She was voted "Class Wit" in high school. c4db6a1d31

Linda Tillery She began her professional singing career at age 19 with the Bay Area rock band The Loading Zone. In addition to performing, she was the producer on three of Olivia's first eight albums. She is recognized as a pioneer in women's music, with her second solo album titled Linda Tillery released on Olivia Records in 1977. Tillery was nominated for a Grammy Award in 1997 for Best Musical Album for Children. Joanna Haigood.
