Taylor began the theory's development in the United States during the 1880s and 1890s within manufacturing industries, especially steel. Its peak of influence came in the 1910s. Although Taylor died in 1915, by the 1920s scientific management was still influential but had entered into competition and syncretism with opposing or complementary ideas.

Shen Kuo Shen was a master in many fields of study including mathematics, optics, and horology. aspects of his father's engagement in administrative governance and the managerial problems involved; these experiences had a deep impact on him as he later Shen Kuo (Chinese: 沈括; 1031-1095) or Shen Gua, courtesy name Cunzhong (存中) and pseudonym Mengqi (now usually given as Mengxi) Weng (孟希), was a Chinese polymath, scientist, and statesman of the Song dynasty (960-1279). In his career as a civil servant, he became a finance minister, governmental state inspector, head official for the Bureau of Astronomy in the Song court, Assistant Minister of Imperial Hospitality, and also served as an academic chancellor. At court his political allegiance was to the Reformist faction known as the New Policies Group, headed by Chancellor Wang Anshi (1021-1085)
