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Fusee (horology) This type is called a going fusee. The watch and clock historian Granville Hugh Baillie stated of the fusee, "Perhaps no problem in mechanics has ever been solved so simply and so perfectly. It was used from the 15th century to the early 20th century to improve timekeeping by equalizing the uneven pull of the mainspring as it ran down. It is usually a planetary gear mechanism (epicyclic gearing) in the base of the fusee "cone" which then provides turning A fusee (from the French fusée, wire wound around a spindle) is a cone-shaped pulley with a helical groove around it, wound with a cord or chain attached to the mainspring barrel of antique mechanical watches and clocks. "

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Frederick W. Lanchester A driveshaft connected the gearbox to a live axle. The new engine and transmission were Frederick William Lanchester (23 October 1868 – 8 March 1946), was an English polymath and engineer who made important contributions to automotive

engineering and to aerodynamics, and co-invented the topic of operations research. re-designed the epicyclic gearbox and combined it with the engine 10d6987b7b

Tank steering systems Half-track vehicles avoid this by combining steerable wheels and fixed-speed tracks. One common example was the Bren Carrier. World War I, and continued into World War II. Differential braking systems are essentially an epicyclic transmission Tank steering systems allow a tank, or other continuous track vehicle, to turn. Because the tracks cannot be angled relative to the hull (in any operational design), steering must be accomplished by speeding one track up, slowing the other down (or reversing it), or a combination of both 10d6987b7b

The power produced by an engine increases with the engine's RPM to a maximum, then falls away. The point of maximum power is somewhat lower than the absolute maximum engine speed to which it is limited, the "redline". Gear In the latter case, the gear is usually called a cogwheel. The teeth can be integral saliences or cavities machined on the part, or separate pegs inserted into it. for gears of particular actual radii are then derived from that. Two or more meshing gears are called a gear train.

Early steering systems were adopted from tracked work vehicles, generally using a clutch to reduce power to one track, causing it to slow down. These designs have numerous problems, notably when climbing hills or running at high speed, as the reduction in power causes the overall speed to slow. Delivering power to both tracks while turning them at different speeds is a difficult design problem. 10d6987b7b

Sturmey-Archer In the past, it also manufactured motorcycle hubs, gearboxes and engines. Sturmey-Archer gear hubs use epicyclic (planetary) geartrains of varying complexity. It primarily produced bicycle hub gears, brakes and a great many other sundry bicycle components, most prominently during its heyday as a subsidiary of the Raleigh Bicycle Company. 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The smaller member of a pair of meshing gears is often called pinion. Most commonly, gears and gear trains can be used to trade torque for rotational speed between two axles or other rotating parts or to change the axis of rotation or to invert the sense of rotation.
