Manual lymphatic drainage Manual lymphatic drainage was pioneered by the Danish doctors Emil Vodder and Estrid Vodder in the 1930s for the treatment of chronic Manual lymphatic drainage (MLD) is a type of manual manipulation of the skin, not to be confused with massage, based on the hypothesis that it will encourage the natural drainage of the lymph, which carries waste products away from the tissues back toward the heart. Manual lymph drainage uses a specific amount of pressure (less than 9 oz per square inch or about 4 kPa), and rhythmic circular movements to stimulate lymph flow. women for the condition. The lymph system depends on intrinsic contractions of the smooth muscle cells in the walls of lymph vessels (peristalsis) and the movement of skeletal muscles to propel lymph

through the vessels to lymph nodes and then to the lymph ducts, which return lymph to the cardiovascular system
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Old Beta Theta Pi Fraternity House It was added to the National Register of Historic Places in 1989. two-story addition was constructed in the mid-1930s, of materials compatible with the original house. It is an American Craftsman and American Foursquare. The house was used by the Beta Theta Pi fraternity of the University of Oregon for fifteen years and by the Delta Zeta sorority for six years. The Oklahoma Constitution established the powers of the Oklahoma House of Representatives in 1907. Voters further

amended those powers through constitutional referendums. One referendum required legislators to balance the annual state budget. Others specified the length and dates of the legislative session. Today, there are 101 House members, each representing a legislative district. District boundaries are redrawn every decade to ensure districts of equal population. Cape Cod (house) Early Cape Cod houses were described as half-houses, and they The Cape Cod house is defined as the classic North American house. popularized in the 1930s–1950s, though traditional unornamented Capes remain common in New England. The basic Cape Cod house dating back to 1670 to now included 4 small rooms surrounding the chimney. If the house had another story, it would include

two even smaller rooms on that second floor. In the original design, Cape Cod houses had the following features: symmetry, steep roofs, central chimneys, windows at the door, flat design, one to one-and-a-half stories, narrow stairways, and simple exteriors. Modern Cape Cod houses more commonly have front porches and decks, as well as external additions made to the houses. Early Cape Cod houses were described as half-houses, and they were 16 to 20 feet wide. The houses have very little overhang and the trim is kept simple. They. Church House, Westminster Its construction was authorised by an act of Parliament, the Church House (Westminster) Act The Church House is the home of the headquarters of the Church of England, occupying the south end of Dean's Yard next to Westminster Abbey in London. Besides providing administrative offices for the Church Commissioners, the

Archbishops' Council and the Church of England Pensions Board, and a chamber for the General Synod, the building also provided a meeting place for the Parliament of the United Kingdom during World War II, and for some of the organs of the newly formed United Nations afterwards, including the first meeting of the UN Security Council. It has more recently been the venue for several notable public inquiries. Herbert Baker, is a 1930s replacement of the original building a5b4573f8b

House slave He characterized the house negro as A house slave was a slave who worked, and often lived, in the house of the slave-owner, performing domestic labor. slaves: "house negroes" who worked in the master's house, and "field negroes" who performed outdoor manual labor. House slaves performed essentially the same

duties as all domestic workers throughout history, such as cooking, cleaning, serving meals, and caring for children; however, their slave status could expose them to more significant abuses, including physical punishments and use for sexual slavery a5b4573f8b

Council house Construction took place mainly from 1919 to 1980s, as a result of the Housing Act 1919. The characterisation of council houses as 'problem places. A council estate is a building complex containing a number of council houses and other amenities like schools and shops. The Housing Acts of 1985 and 1988 facilitated the transfer of council housing to not-for-profit housing associations with access to private finance, and these new housing associations became the providers of most new public-sector housing. and the Design Manual written according to the 1913 building standards. In 1923 the Chamberlain Act withdrew subsidies for council houses except for private A

council house, corporation house or council flat is a form of British public housing built by local authorities. Though more council houses have been built since then, fewer have been built in recent years. Local design variations exist, however all followed local authority building standards a5b4573f8b
