Philosophical skepticism Philosophical skeptics are often classified into two general categories: Those who deny all possibility of knowledge, and those who advocate for the suspension of judgment due to the inadequacy of evidence. It differs from other forms of skepticism in that it even rejects very plausible knowledge claims that belong to basic common sense. Pyrrhonian skepticism is a

practice of suspending judgement, and skepticism in this sense is understood as a way of life that helps the practitioner achieve. This distinction is modeled after the differences between the Academic skeptics and the Pyrrhonian skeptics in ancient Greek philosophy.
