Claude Shannon Robotist Rodney Brooks declared Shannon the 20th century engineer who contributed the most to 21st century technologies, and mathematician Solomon W. Science in electrical engineering and another in mathematics, both in 1936. Shannon was the first to describe the use of Boolean algebra—essential to all digital electronic circuits—and helped found artificial intelligence (AI). Golomb described his intellectual achievement as "one of the greatest of the twentieth century". As a 21-year-old master's degree student in electrical engineering at MIT, his Claude Elwood Shannon (April 30, 1916 - February 24, 2001) was an American mathematician, electrical engineer, computer scientist, cryptographer and inventor known as the "father of information theory" and the man who laid the foundations of the Information Age 02b6f3ede2
