Final Cut Studio Upon its discontinuation, Final Cut Studio was Final Cut Studio is a discontinued suite of professional video production and post-production made by Apple for the Mac. It first went on sale in 2005. The suite competed with Avid Media Composer for the high-end movie production market. release of Final Cut Pro X, Apple discontinued Final Cut Studio, Final Cut Express, and Final Cut Server 83d37799bd

An earlier incarnation of the package, Soundtrack, was first sold as part of Apple's Final Cut Pro 4 video editor, released in April 2003. It was then released as a stand-alone product, but due to low demand it was discontinued. The main concept of Soundtrack was to allow people who are not professional composers to produce original music for their videos or DVDs, royalty-free. The music could be easily scored to QuickTime movies and Final Cut Pro projects. Soundtrack was reinstated in January 2005 as part of Final Cut Express HD. Soundtrack and all future versions contains a DVD of Apple Loops that were also part of the GarageBand Loops. 83d37799bd

It is the successor of the Apple Intermediate Codec and was introduced in 2007 with Final Cut Studio 2. It is recommended for use with all HD workflows in Final Cut Express, iMovie, and until Final Cut Pro version 5. The Apple Intermediate Codec abbreviated AIC (by users, Apple Engineers don't use the abbreviation) is designed by Apple Inc. to be an intermediate format in an HDV and AVCHD workflow. It features high performance and quality, being less processor intensive to work with than other editing formats. It was updated to version 1.2 in the

following year; this version was then included in Final Cut Express HD in 2005. Version 2 of LiveType was then released with version 5 of Final Cut Pro, and this was included in version 3.5 of Final Cut Express in May 2006. The program was packaged with Final Cut Studio until version 3. The upgrade changed the pricing structure by eliminating the original 10-client license and reducing the cost of the unlimited client license to \$999. Upgrades from Final Cut Studio v1.1.1 to v1.5 for both the unlimited... 83d37799bd In 2011, after the release of Final Cut Pro X, Apple discontinued Final Cut Studio, Final Cut Express, and Final Cut Server. Upon its discontinuation, Final Cut Studio was no longer on sale in Apple Stores or on Apple's website, but was still available through Apple's phone sales. Its three primary applications Final Cut Pro, Motion, and Compressor, are still actively developed, and available on the Mac App Store. As of 2017, Final Cut Pro 7 no longer runs on macOS High Sierra or later; it can be patched to run on recent versions of macOS, though this is not supported by Apple. 83d37799bd

LiveType originated from a product called "India Titler Pro," by the Oregon-based company Prismo Graphics, founded by Tom Langmacher and Mary Massey (now Mary Wolf). Prismo Graphics hired Dave Howell of Pablo Media to write the software's code. Prismo Graphics, as well as the software, was acquired by Apple in June 2002. 83d37799bd

Final Cut Express As of June 21, 2011, Final Cut Express was discontinued in favor of Final Cut Pro X. 0, based on Final Cut Pro 3, was released at Macworld Final Cut Express was a video editing software suite created by Apple Inc. The third version, capable of editing high definition video, was also announced at Macworld San Francisco a year later, and was released as Final Cut Express HD in February 2005. It was based on Final Cut Pro HD (version 4.5) and included LiveType 1.2 and Soundtrack 1.2. Apple announced the discontinuation of the software in June 2011, replacing it with Final Cut Pro X. It also made inroads with film and television editors who have traditionally used Avid Media Composer. According to a 2007 SCRI study, Final Cut Pro made up 49% of the United States professional editing market, with Avid at 22%. A published survey in 2008 by the American Cinema Editors Guild placed their users at 21% Final Cut Pro (and growing from previous surveys of this group), while all others were on an Avid system of some kind. In 2011, Final Cut Pro 7 was replaced with the fully rewritten Final Cut Pro X, which initially lacked many features from previous versions, though frequent updates have brought back many of these features. Final Cut Pro for iPad was made available on May 23, 2023.
