Scots law Together with English law and Northern Irish law, it is one of the three legal systems of the United Kingdom. Scots law recognises four sources of law: legislation, legal precedent, specific academic writings, and custom. Legislation affecting Scotland and Scots law is passed by the Scottish Parliament on all areas of devolved responsibility, and the United Kingdom Parliament on reserved matters. Some legislation passed by the pre-1707 Parliament of Scotland is still also valid. It is a hybrid or mixed legal system containing civil law and common law elements, that traces its roots to a number of different historical sources. The work is an important historical source for the study of the Middle Ages. commentary and manuscript information.
