Value-form 141–142 The value-form or form of value ("Wertform" in German) is an important concept in Karl Marx's critique of political economy, discussed in the first chapter of Capital, Volume 1. objects. The physical appearance or the price tag of a traded object may be directly observable, but the meaning of its social form (as an object of value) is not. It refers to the social form of tradeable things as units of value, which contrast with their tangible features, as objects which can satisfy human needs and wants or serve a useful purpose. Marx intended to correct errors made by the classical economists in their definitions of exchange, value, money and capital, by showing more precisely how these economic categories evolved out of the development of trading relations themselves.
