It was developed by psychoanalyst Aaron Beck in the 1950's. This alteration in a person's thinking produces less anxiety and depression. This therapy focuses on challenging unhelpful and irrational negative thoughts and beliefs, referred to as 'self-talk' and replacing them with more rational positive self-talk f393d7163f

The central premise is that emotions influence cognition, motivate behavior, and are strongly linked to needs.
