

Il Principio Passione

During the Gothic Wars the city of Lucca was besieged and taken by Totila in 550. Hoping for assistance from the Franks, the Lucchesi obstinately resisted the attack of Narses, surrendering only after a siege of seven months (553). It later fell into the hands of the Lombards, was thenceforward a place of great importance, and became the favourite seat of the Marquesses of Tuscany. During the fifth century the city was destroyed... In Orte, the cathedral was named Santa Maria Maggiore, and dedicated to the Assumption of the Virgin Mary. The cathedral was served by an ecclesiastical corporation called the Chapter, which was composed of one dignity (the Provost) and seventeen (or eighteen) canons.

== History == According to a local tradition, the first bishop of Terracina was St. Epaphroditus, who is claimed to have been one of Jesus' original seventy-two disciples, mentioned by Paul of Tarsus in one of his epistles. The most ancient Christian record of the city is that of the martyrdom of St. Julianus, priest, and St. Cæsareus, deacon, who were cast into the sea under the emperor Trajan. The early date is rejected by Francesco Lanzoni, along with many hagiographical details. In the third century, a Quartus is recorded by the "Passion of S. Caesareo" as a sacerdos, and martyr along with Caesareo; he is also mentioned as a martyr along with Quintus... In the bull "Sacrosancta Romana" of 5 October 1437, Pope Eugenius IV united the dioceses of Orte and Civita Castellana under one bishop. == The beginnings == In 981 Otto II, Holy Roman Emperor bestowed on its bishop civil jurisdiction over the entire diocesan territory; but in 1081 Emperor Henry IV made it a free city and conferred other favours upon it, especially in the way of trade. Under Aragonese control, Catalan and Castilian became the island's prestige... Concordia is an ancient Venetian city, called by the Romans Colonia Julia, and is situated on the Lemene River, between the Rivers Tagliamento and Livenza, two miles south of Portogruaro, not far from the Adriatic. Today there remain of the city only ruins and the ancient cathedral. The eighty-nine martyrs of Concordia, who were put to death under Diocletian, are held in veneration; their cult is recent, however, and based on late and dubious material.
