Attributed to American philosopher Edmund Gettier, Gettier-type counterexamples (called "Gettier-cases")

challenge the long-held justified true belief (JTB) account of knowledge. anti-reductionist accounts are unlikely to please those who have other reasons to hold fast to the method behind JTB+G accounts. The JTB account holds that knowledge is equivalent to justified true belief; if all three conditions (justification, truth, and belief) are met of a given claim, then there is knowledge of that claim. Fred Dretske developed an account of The Gettier problem, in the field of epistemology, is a landmark philosophical problem concerning the understanding of descriptive knowledge. This problem has been a central issue in philosophy of mind since the 17th century, particularly following René Descartes' formulation of dualism, which proposes that mind and body are fundamentally distinct substances.
