Articles which are subject to repeated frequent or particularly insidious vandalism can be semi-protected to prevent editing by logged-out editors and newly-registered accounts. If you are having difficulty with an individual evading blocks for vandalism, you should be able to get help from an administrator at WP:AIV or WP:ANI.
