Factor analysis The observed variables are modelled as linear combinations of the potential factors plus "error" terms, hence factor analysis can be thought of as a special case of errors-in-variables models. Factor analysis searches for such joint variations in response to unobserved latent variables. considerably influenced by sample size, item discrimination, and type of correlation coefficient. For example, it is possible that variations in six observed variables mainly reflect the variations in two unobserved (underlying) variables. Velicer's (1976) MAP test as described by Courtney (2013) Factor analysis is a statistical method used to describe variability among observed, correlated variables in terms of a potentially lower number of unobserved variables called factors 8e7c0f5b37

The correlation between a variable and a given factor, called the variable's factor loading, indicates the extent to which the two are related. Scores from intelligence tests are estimates of intelligence. Unlike quantities such as distance and mass, a concrete measure of intelligence cannot be achieved...
