Each ion can be either monatomic, such as sodium (Na^+) and chloride (Cl^-) in sodium chloride, or polyatomic, such as ammonium (NH_4^+) and carbonate (CO_3^{2-}) ions in ammonium carbonate. Salts containing basic ions hydroxide (OH^-) or oxide (O^{2-}) are classified as bases, such as sodium hydroxide and potassium oxide. 62987aef9c Seventeen elements are widely recognized as nonmetals.
