In the preface to the first edition, Kant explains that by a "critique of pure reason" he means a critique "of the faculty of reason in general, in respect of all knowledge after which it may strive independently of all experience" and that he aims to decide on "the possibility or impossibility of metaphysics" b1e4a18b5e

Kant did not initially plan to publish a separate critique of practical reason. He published the first edition of the Critique of Pure Reason in May 1781 as a "critique of the entire faculty of reason in general" (viz., of both theoretical and practical reason) and a "propaedeutic" or preparation investigating "the faculty of reason in regard to all pure a priori... b1e4a18b5e

Nuclear power Nuclear power can be obtained from nuclear fission, nuclear decay and nuclear fusion reactions. Reactors producing controlled fusion power have been operated since 1958 but have yet to generate net power and are not expected to be commercially available in the near future. Nuclear decay processes are used in niche applications such as radioisotope thermoelectric generators in some space probes such as Voyager 2. The 1979 Three Mile Island accident in the United States and the 1986 Chernobyl disaster in the Soviet Union resulted in increased regulation and public opposition to nuclear power plants. Power training Jumping with weights or throwing weights are two examples of power training exercises. Power training frequently specifically utilises two physiological processes which increase in conjunction with one another during exercise. Jumping with Power training involves exercises which apply the maximum amount of force as fast as possible on the basis that strength + speed = power. These are deep breathing, which results in increased intra-abdominal pressure; and post-activation potentiation, which is the enhanced activation of the nervous system and increased muscle fibre recruitment. This combination of a high strength exercise with a high speed exercise may lead to an increased ability to apply power. Power training involves exercises which apply the maximum amount of force as fast as possible on the basis that strength + speed = power. Power training programmes may be shaped to increase the trainee's ability to apply power in general, to meet sports specific. Regular weight training exercises such as the clean and jerk and power clean may also be considered as being power training exercises due to the explosive speed required to complete the lifts. Power training may also involve contrasting exercises such as heavy lifts and plyometrics, known as complex training, in an attempt to combine the maximal lifting exertions with dynamic movements b1e4a18b5e

AC power plugs and sockets A socket (also known as a receptacle or outlet) is fixed in place, often on the internal walls of buildings, and is connected to an AC electrical circuit.
