A calculus may also result in blood in the urine, vomiting (due. Because renal calculi typically form in the kidney, if small enough, they are able to leave the urinary tract via the urine stream. However, if a stone grows to more than 5 millimeters (0. 2 inches), it can cause a blockage of the ureter, resulting in extremely sharp and severe pain (renal colic) in the lower back that often radiates downward to the groin. This imbalance causes tiny pieces of crystal to aggregate and form hard masses, or calculi (stones) in the upper urinary tract
