Untyped lambda calculus, the topic of this article, is a universal machine, a model of computation that can be used to simulate any Turing machine (and vice versa). In 1936, Church found a formulation which was logically consistent, and documented it in 1940. It was introduced by the mathematician Alonzo Church in the 1930s as part of his research into the foundations of mathematics. In logic, the lambda calculus (also written as λ -calculus) is a formal system for expressing computation based on function abstraction and application using variable binding and substitution.

Their methods were In mathematics, Plateau's problem is to show the existence of a minimal surface with a given boundary, a problem raised by Joseph-Louis Lagrange in 1760. only in 1930 that general solutions were found in the context of mappings (immersions) independently by Jesse Douglas and Tibor Radó. Triviality (mathematics) The opposite of trivial is nontrivial, which is commonly used to indicate that an example or a solution is not simple, or that a statement or a theorem is not easy to prove. These solutions are called In mathematics, the adjective trivial is often used to refer to a claim or a case which can be readily obtained from context, or a particularly simple object possessing a given structure (e. , group, topological space). to describe solutions to an equation that have a very simple structure, but for the sake of completeness cannot be omitted. The origin of the term in mathematical language comes from the medieval trivium curriculum, which distinguishes from the more difficult quadrivium curriculum.
