Dean Smith Smith won his first national championship with his 1981–82 team, which was composed of future NBA players such as Michael Jordan, James Worthy Dean Edwards Smith (February 28, 1931 – February 7, 2015) was an American men's college basketball head coach. During his tenure as head coach, North Carolina won two national championships and appeared in 11 Final Fours. Smith's career total of 879 wins lasted until 2005 when Pat Summitt surpassed him with her 880th victory. Called a "coaching legend" by the Basketball Hall of Fame, he coached for 36 years at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. Smith coached from 1961 to 1997 and retired with 879 victories, which was the NCAA Division I men's basketball record at that time. [a] Smith had the ninth-highest winning percentage of any men's college basketball coach (77.
