The axons from the lower motor neurons are efferent nerve fibers that carry signals from the spinal cord to the effectors. Its cell body is located in the motor cortex, brainstem or the spinal cord, and whose axon (fiber) projects to the spinal cord or outside of the spinal cord to directly or indirectly control effector organs, mainly muscles and glands.
