Based upon review of the flight data recorder, Boeing concluded that nine seconds after takeoff, the flight crew had inadvertently turned off the water injection pumps in response to warnings, which reduced thrust. Turning off the pumps when the plane was in takeoff climb limited the plane's ability to climb. Boeing states that thrust was increased manually after 325 seconds and then the plane climbed normally. b466e3b866

Qantas Flight 1 Hemisphere. This flight was operated by Senior Check Captain Jack Fried in Boeing 747-438 registered VH-OJH. On 23 September 1999, the aircraft operating as Flight 1 had departed from Sydney that day, and was involved in a runway overrun accident at Don Mueang International Airport in Bangkok as it was landing for a stopover. UPS Airlines Flight 6 The accident prompted a re-evaluation of safety procedures protecting airliners from cockpit smoke. It was the first fatal air crash for UPS Airlines. On September 3, 2010, the Boeing 747-400F flying the route between Dubai, United Arab Emirates, and Cologne, Germany, developed an in-flight fire, which caused the aircraft to crash, killing both crew members, the only people on board. Tenerife airport disaster The incident occurred at 5:06 pm WET (UTC+0) in dense fog, when KLM Flight 4805 initiated its takeoff run, colliding with the right side of Pan Am Flight 1736 still on the runway. The impact and the resulting fire killed all 248 people on board the KLM plane and 335 of the 396 people on board the Pan Am plane, with only 61 survivors in the front section of the latter aircraft. With a total of 583 fatalities, the disaster is the deadliest accident in aviation history b466e3b866

Tower Air Flight 41 All 468 people on board survived, but 25 people were injured. On December 20, 1995, the Boeing 747-100 operating the flight veered off the runway during takeoff from JFK. The aircraft was damaged beyond repair and written off, making the accident the 25th hull loss of a Boeing 747. The National Transportation Safety Board (NTSB) concluded that the captain had failed to reject the takeoff in a timely manner. Visual approach This approach must be authorized and under the control of the appropriate air traffic control (ATC) facility.
