Precision-guided munition STRIX is fired like a conventional mortar round. manufactured by Saab Bofors Dynamics. PGMs are designed to precisely hit a predetermined target, typically with a margin of error (or circular error probable, CEP) that is far smaller than conventional unguided munitions. Unlike unguided munitions, PGMs use active or passive control mechanisms capable of steering the weapon towards its intended target. PGMs are capable of mid-flight course corrections, allowing them to adjust and hit the intended target even if conditions. In late Autumn 1946, development of the Lansen began as a successor to the Saab B 18/S 18 attack aircraft. As the design was refined, plans to use the indigenous STAL Doverturbojet engine were put aside due to technical difficulties in favour of the license-built Rolls-Royce Avon powerplant.
