Strategy Henry Mintzberg from McGill University defined strategy as a pattern in a stream of decisions Strategy (from Greek στρατηγία stratēgia, "troop leadership; office of general, command, generalship") is a general plan to achieve one or more long-term or overall goals under conditions of uncertainty. , the term came into use in the 6th century C. From then until the 20th century, the word "strategy" came to denote "a comprehensive way to try to pursue political ends, including the threat or actual use of force, in a dialectic of wills" in a military conflict, in which both adversaries interact. In the sense of the "art of the general", which included several subsets of skills including military tactics, siegecraft, logistics etc. in Eastern Roman terminology, and was translated into Western vernacular languages only in the 18th century.
