Leopold Report The Robbins Report was released on August The Leopold Report, officially known as Wildlife Management in the National Parks, is a 1963 paper composed of a series of ecosystem management recommendations that were presented by the Special Advisory Board on Wildlife Management to United States Secretary of the Interior Stewart Udall. Named for its chairman and principal author, zoologist and conservationist A. more commonly known as the Robbins Report, was named after its primary author, biologist William J. Robbins.
