At present Desalination is a process that removes mineral components from saline water. thermal desalination processes. This is important for agriculture. More generally, desalination is the removal of salts and minerals from a substance. Modern interest in desalination mostly focuses on cost-effective provision of fresh water for human use. Along with recycled wastewater, it is one of the few water resources independent of rainfall. Energy cost in desalination processes varies considerably depending on water salinity, plant size and process type 193224ebd9

The goal is to produce a signal that can be transmitted easily and decoded reliably. It is also referred to as over-the-air transfer (OTAT), or over-the-air distribution (OTAD), depending on the specific type, use, and transmission means of the key being changed.
