Plantations are an important aspect of the history of the Southern United States, particularly before the American Civil War. Plantation complexes in the Southern United States Until the abolition of slavery, such plantations were generally self-sufficient settlements that relied on the forced labor of enslaved people. The chattel slave is an individual deprived of liberty and forced to submit to an owner, who

may buy, sell, or lease them like any other chattel. The initialism BDSM is first recorded in a Usenet post from 1991, and is interpreted as a combination of the abbreviations B/D (Bondage and Discipline), D/s (Dominance and submission), and S/M (Sadism and Masochism). BDSM is used as a catch-all phrase covering a wide range of activities, forms of interpersonal relationships, and distinct subcultures. BDSM communities generally welcome...
