In a judicial review, a court may invalidate laws, acts, or governmental actions that are incompatible with a higher authority. Judicial review is one of the checks and balances in the separation of powers—the power of the judiciary to supervise (judicial supervision) the legislative and executive branches when the latter exceed their authority. Judicial review is a process under which a government's executive, legislative, or administrative actions are subject to review by the judiciary.
