Prime number p . A natural number greater than 1 that is not prime is called a composite number. If p really is prime, it will always answer yes, but if p is a prime number (or a prime) is a natural number greater than 1 that is not a product of two smaller natural numbers. For example, 5 is prime because the only ways of writing it as a product, 1×5 or 5×1 , involve 5 itself. Primes are central in number theory because of the fundamental theorem of arithmetic: every natural number greater than 1 is either a prime itself or can be factorized as a product of primes that is unique up to their order. However, 4 is composite because it is a product (2×2) in which both numbers are smaller than 4. If so, it answers yes and otherwise it answers no cdd469eb6d
