Pegasus is the creator of Hippocrene, the fountain on Mount Helicon. He was captured by the Greek hero Bellerophon, near the fountain Peirene, with the help of Athena and Poseidon. Pegasus allowed Bellerophon to ride him in order to defeat the monster Chimera, which led to many more exploits. Bellerophon later fell from Pegasus's back while trying to reach Mount Olympus. Both Pegasus and Bellerophon were said to have died at the hands of Zeus for trying to reach Olympus. Pegasus was the brother of Chrysaor, both born from Medusa's blood when their mother was decapitated by Perseus. He was sired by Poseidon, in his role as horse-god, and foaled by the Gorgon Medusa. Moving to Paris in 1909, he joined the avant-garde scene, he was a leading Cubist sculptor. During this time, Lipchitz met Pablo Picasso whose cubist works and philosophy inspired the work.
