Before sound-on-film technology became viable, soundtracks for films were commonly played live with organs or pianos. It has a population of about 52 million, of which half live in the Seoul Metropolitan Area, the ninth most populous metropolitan area in the world; other major cities include Busan, Daegu, and Incheon
