Rail transport in Indonesia Indonesia targets to extend the national railway network to 10,524 kilometres by 2030. Indonesia has finalized its plan for a national railway network recently. As of September 2022, the network spans 7,032 km. It has been touted as the most extensive railway project in Indonesia since its independence from the Dutch in 1945.
