Chinese, was replaced with written vernacular Chinese, which drew its vocabulary and grammar from a range of Northern dialects (now known as Mandarin dialects) Mandarin (traditional Chinese: 官話; simplified Chinese: 官话; pinyin: Guānhuà; lit.
