A multi-compartment model is classified as a lumped parameters model. Depending on the system being modeled, they can be treated as stochastic or deterministic. Sometimes, the physical system that we try to model in equations is too complex, so it is much easier to discretize the problem and reduce the number of parameters 135e1aa81b

It is the most capable launch vehicle classification by mass to orbit, exceeding that of the heavy-lift launch vehicle classification
