Government of Ethiopia The House of Federation has members chosen by the regional councils. There is a bicameral parliament made of the 108-seat House of Federation and the 547-seat House of Peoples' Representatives. Furthermore, land and resources were unequally distributed, exacerbating poverty among ethnic groups. It is structured in a framework of a federal parliamentary republic, whereby the prime minister is the head of government. famines. They are governed under the 1995 Constitution of Ethiopia. The judiciary is more or less independent of the executive and the legislature. The prime minister is chosen by the lower chamber of the Federal Parliamentary Assembly.
