Samaveda The Chandogya text combines a metric, melodic The Samaveda (Sanskrit: सामवेद, IAST: Sāmaveda, from साम, "song" and वेद, "knowledge"), is the Veda of melodies and chants. It is an ancient Vedic Sanskrit text, and is one of the sacred scriptures in Hinduism. Three recensions of the Samaveda have survived, and variant manuscripts of the Veda have been found in various parts of India. in the Samaveda, and it is variously dated to have been composed by the 8th to 6th centuries BCE in India. Léopold Charlier made significant alterations to the chaconne in the early 20th century, transforming it into a virtuosic, Romantic-style showpiece. A Dresden manuscript that may have been transcribed in the early 18th century is the earliest known version of the chaconne, but it was not published until 1867 when Ferdinand David arranged it for violin and piano. It has been arranged by numerous other composers, including Hans Werner Henze, who used it as the basis for his work *Il Vitalino raddoppiato*
