Costa-Gavras was born in Loutra Iraitas, Arcadia. His family spent the Second World War in a village in the Peloponnese, and moved to Athens after the war. Kanō Jigorō He first tried techniques from sumo taught by a former practitioner named Uchiyama Kanō Jigorō (Kanō Jigorō; 10 December 1860 – 4 May 1938) was a Japanese judoka, educator, politician, and the founder of judo. school. Well-known mottoes attributed to Kanō include "maximum efficiency minimal effort" (seiryoku zen'yō) and "mutual welfare and benefit" (jita kyōei). Therefore, Kanō started trying unfamiliar techniques on his rival. Judo was one of the first Japanese martial arts to gain widespread international recognition, and the first to become an official Olympic sport since 1964 (for men) and 1992 (for women), as well as the Commonwealth Games sport in 1990. Pedagogical innovations attributed to Kanō include the use of black and white belts, and the introduction of dan ranking to show the relative ranking among members of a martial-art-style 3bcfcfbf091

Vestiges of the Natural History of Creation Sedgwick added a 400+ page preface to the 5th edition of his *Vestiges of the Natural History of Creation* is an 1844 work of speculative natural history and philosophy by Robert Chambers.
