It also neutralizes acids that originate from fuel and from oxidation of the lubricant (detergents), improves the sealing of piston rings, and cools the engine by carrying heat away from moving parts. Nearly all commercial motor oils contain additives, whether the oils are synthetic or petroleum based.
