These salts are colorless or white solids that are highly soluble in water. used for dust control, soil stabilization, and wind erosion

mitigation. Anhydrous magnesium chloride is the principal precursor to magnesium metal, which is produced on a large scale. When magnesium chloride is applied to roads and bare soil areas, both positive and Magnesium chloride is an inorganic compound with the formula MgCl_2 .
