Electronic flight instrument system EICAS displays In aviation, an electronic flight instrument system (EFIS) is a flight instrument display system in an aircraft cockpit that displays flight data electronically rather than electromechanically. Early EFIS models used cathode-ray tube (CRT) displays, but liquid crystal displays (LCD) are now more common. Now, however, few flight deck instruments cannot be replaced by an electronic display. The complex electromechanical attitude director indicator (ADI) and horizontal situation indicator (HSI) were the first candidates for replacement by EFIS.
