The work is a critique of what Deleuze calls 'representation': a mode of thought where things become intelligible only by being placed under concepts, compared, categorized, and recognized. For example: this object is a tree because it fits the basic conceptual identity of "tree." Instead of treating identity as basic and difference as secondary, Deleuze treats difference as primary and identity as a temporary effect. He develops concepts of difference in itself and repetition for itself, that is, concepts of difference and repetition that are logically and metaphysically prior to any concept of identity. True repetition is the repetition of difference. de30e7b7a3 == History == de30e7b7a3 Today, FDMs are one of the most common approaches to the numerical solution of PDE, along with finite element methods. de30e7b7a3 While Monte Carlo methods only adjust their estimates once the outcome is known, TD methods adjust predictions to match later, more-accurate predictions about the future, before the outcome is known.
