Cat food The idea of specialized cat food came later than dog food, as cats were believed to be self-sufficient hunters. French writers in the 1800s criticized this notion, arguing that well-fed cats were more effective hunters. Cat food is food specifically formulated and designed for consumption by cats. Cats, as obligate carnivores, require animal protein for essential nutrients like taurine and arginine, which they cannot synthesize from plant-based sources. Pet door A related concept is the pet gate, which is easy for humans to open but acts as a secure pet barrier. 2007 pet food recalls cases of 20 dogs and 7 cats reported from Canada. The recalls in North America, Europe, and South Africa came in response to reports of kidney failure in pets.
