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Linus Pauling Pauling was one of the founders of the fields of quantum chemistry and molecular biology. New Scientist called him one of the 20 greatest scientists of all time. He is one of five people to have won more than one Nobel Prize. For his peace activism, he was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize in 1962. Skłodowska-Curie. For his scientific work, Pauling was awarded the Nobel Prize in Chemistry in 1954. Of these, he is the only person to have been awarded two unshared Nobel Prizes, and one of two people to be awarded Nobel Prizes in different fields, the other being Marie Skłodowska-Curie. His contributions to the theory of the chemical Linus Carl Pauling (PAW-ling; February 28, 1901 – August 19, 1994) was an American chemist and peace activist. He published more than 1,200 papers and books, of

which about 850 dealt with scientific topics
