The term geriatrics originates from the Greek γέρων geron meaning "old man", and ιατρός iatros meaning "healer". Research regarding late-life depression often focuses on late-onset depression, which is defined as a major depressive episode occurring for the first time in an older person (various sources define this threshold differently, typically within the range of 60-65 years old). In the geriatric population specifically, including patients over the age of 85, ECT provides a safe and effective treatment option Late-life depression refers to depression occurring in older adults and has diverse presentations, including as a recurrence of early-onset depression, a new diagnosis of late-onset depression, and a mood disorder resulting from a separate medical condition, substance use, or medication regimen 21904e33f2
